North Island Credit Union Awards Grant to Mt. Carmel High School Teacher

San Diego, CA – June 7, 2019 – North Island Credit Union recently awarded a \$500 grant to Mt. Carmel High School Teacher Alison Talle as part of its Spring 2019 Teacher Grant program, which assists educators in funding innovative learning opportunities for their students. Located in the Poway Unified School District, the Mt. Carmel High School grant will be used to develop a garden filled with California native plans to attract butterflies. The garden is being developed by multiple classes covering different STEAM-related subjects.

Any full-time classroom teacher in San Diego County can apply for a grant for a program that has clearly defined learning objectives tied to students' academic needs, displays creativity in education, and targets a significant number of students.
